

## 780s

Blindspot Gallery's latest show, "780s" (or seven eighties) rounds up seven Hong Kong artists born in the 80s (surprise, surprise) for a fantastic group show of new digital works. They explore different ways of working with photography in today's rapid-fire, image-heavy world. For instance, South Ho Siu-nam investigates a post-handover Hong Kong by melding photography and installation in "Defense and Resistance"; and through engraved photographs, Trevor Yeung gives us a whimsical peek at sleeping strangers in a New York hostel in "Sleepy Beds." Other artists featured include Eason Tsang, Siu Wai-hang, Lai Lon-hin, Cheung Wai-lok and Doreen Chan. Through Jan 10, 2015.
