Born in 1980, in Hong Kong, Chow Chun Fai graduated from the Chinese University of Hong Kong, the Department of Fine Arts, with a BA and MFA. Group exhibitions in which Chow has recently participated include “Venice Meeting Point” (Arsenale, Venice Biennale, 2015); “The Past Continuing” (Hong Kong Heritage Museum, Hong Kong, 2015); and the Liverpool Biennial (Liverpool, UK, 2012).
