Paul Barlow (b.1988, Sheffield, UK) is a painter who graduated from the Royal Academy Schools in 2021 and was recently selected for Bloomberg New Contemporaries at the South London Gallery. Barlow's unique method of using water as a solvent to strip away residues of colour using repetitive motions, abstracts universal patterns observed in the physical world.
